PARKING - Designated handicap, home, and visiting parking.

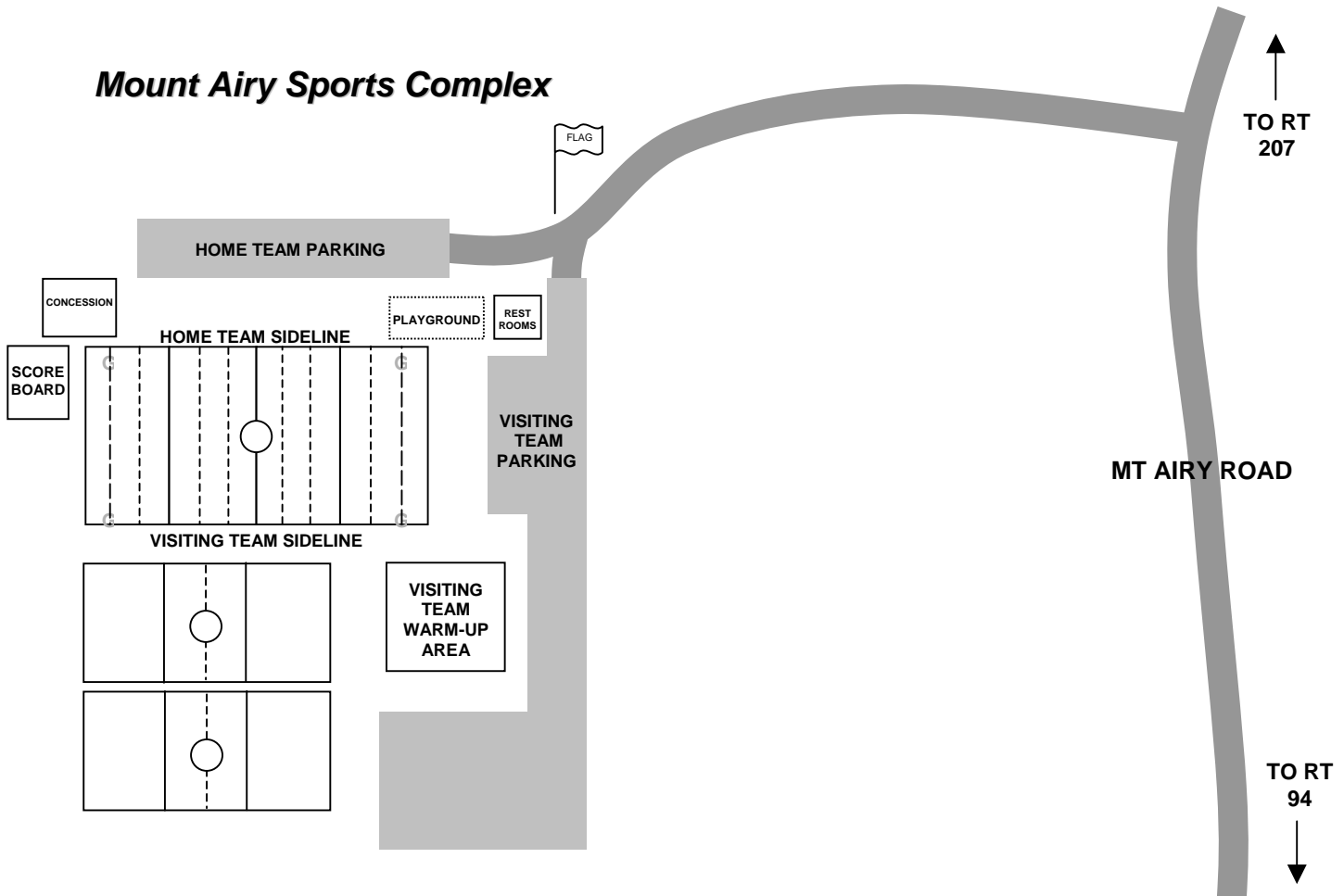
PLAYGROUND/RESTROOMS - Full size youth playground and full size restrooms available, located near flagpole.

FROM MIDDLETOWN - Rt 84 East to Exit 7S (Rt 300). Take 300 South to 4th light, follow 300 South to the left. Go to 3rd light make right on to Rt 94 West. Go 1 mile and Mt Airy Road is on Right. Follow Mt Airy Rd 1/2 mile and complex is on Left.

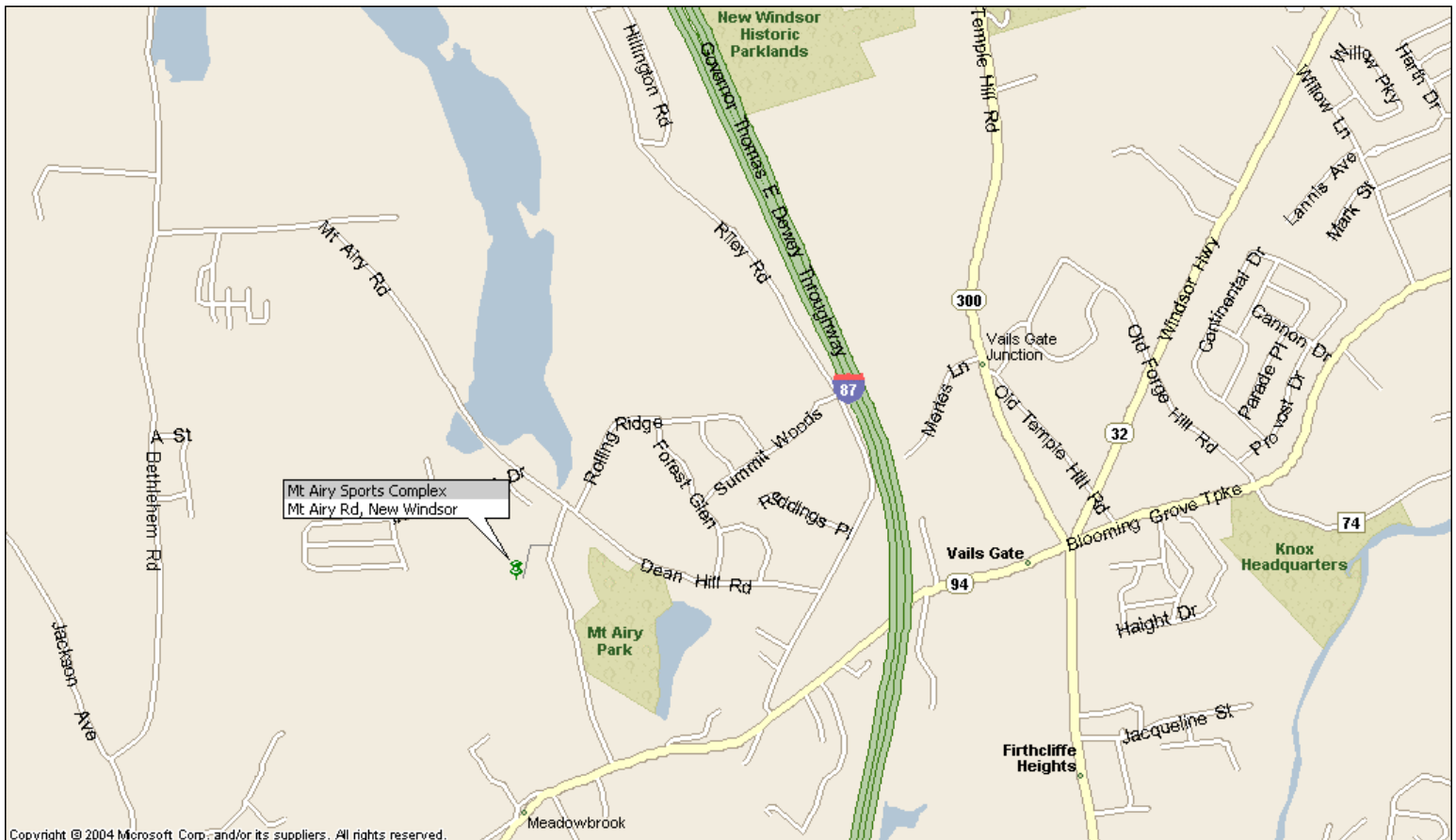
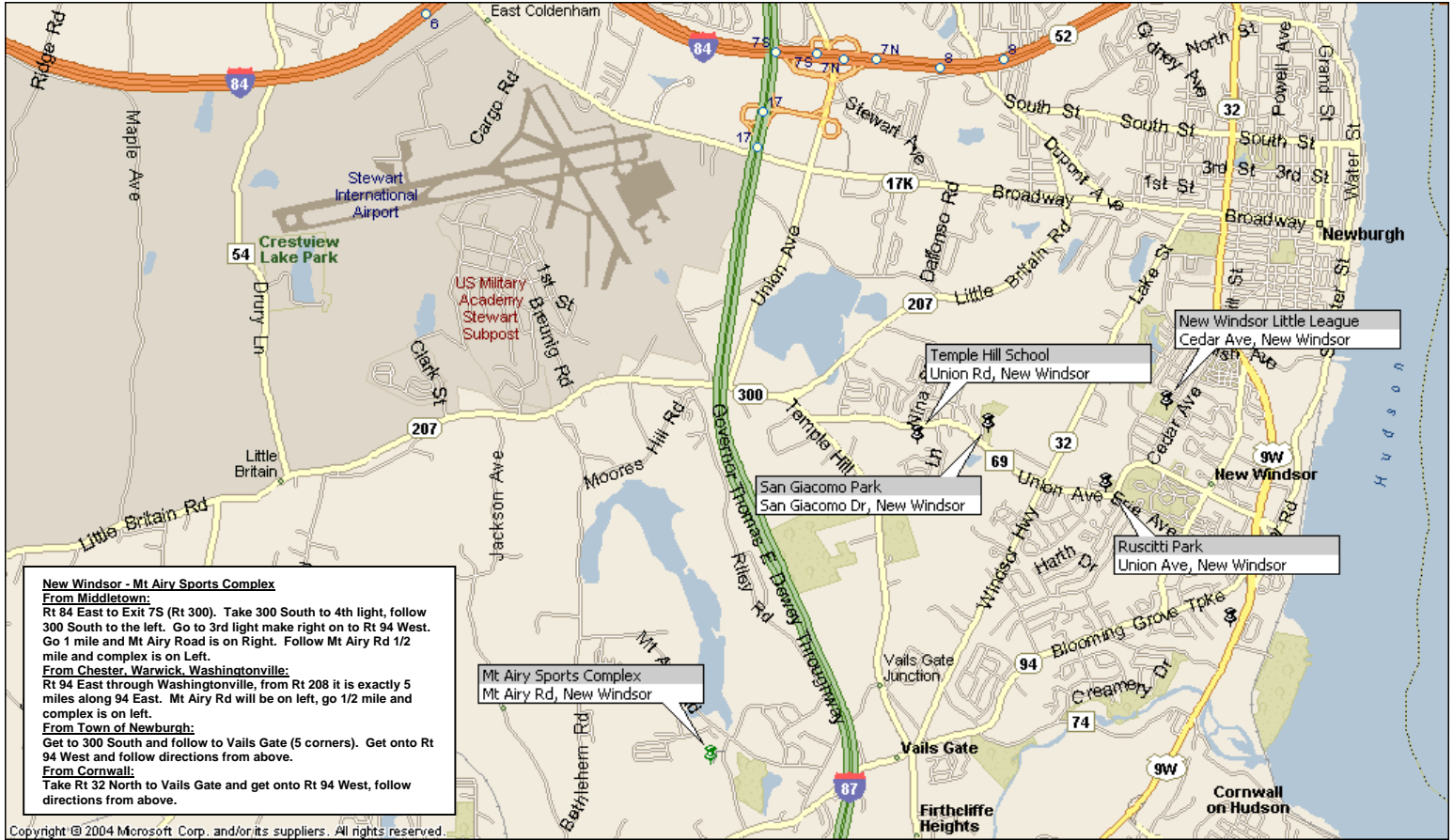
FROM CHESTER, WARWICK, WASHINGTONVILLE - Rt 94 East through Washingtonville, from Rt 208 it is exactly 5 miles along 94 East. Mt Airy Rd will be on left, go 1/2 mile and complex is on left.

FROM TOWN OF NEWBURGH - Get to 300 South and follow to Vails Gate (5 corners). Get onto Rt 94 West and follow directions from above.

FROM CORNWALL - Take Rt 32 North to Vails Gate and get onto Rt 94 West, follow directions from above.

Mt. Airy Sports Complex Rules

No foul language

If a participant is overheard by an official, league coordinator, or recreation staff member using foul language or using any foul gestures towards an individual – he/she will be suspended for one year from date of incident from all recreation programs and trips.

Fighting

Any player, coach, spectator or official who engages in physical fighting will be suspended indefinitely.

The Town Supervisor may review this suspension after one (1) year.

Spectators, Coaches and Officials

No verbal abuse or personal harassment will be tolerated.

No verbal threatening will be tolerated, if verbal threatening occurs you will be asked to leave the facility and you will be suspended for up to one (1) year from date of incident from all town programs and trips.

The Town Supervisor may review this suspension after one (1) year.

Equipment

Anyone found removing town owned equipment from any town facility will be suspended from all programs and trips for one (1) year from date of incident.

No alcohol or drugs allowed in park

No pets allowed in park

Please use bathrooms

No smoking or chewing tobacco near player's bench

Please pick up trash in park

Spectators should watch game from bleacher area

No spectators are allowed near playing area

No maintenance on fields

No cutting grass on fields

No marking lines on fields

No snow plowing off fields

Parking

Cars must be parked between lines. Parking prohibited on grass.

No parking on Mt. Airy Road or in front of entrance gate.

Violations of these rules by players, coaches, team, spectators or officials, may result in a one-year suspension from all town parks and programs
